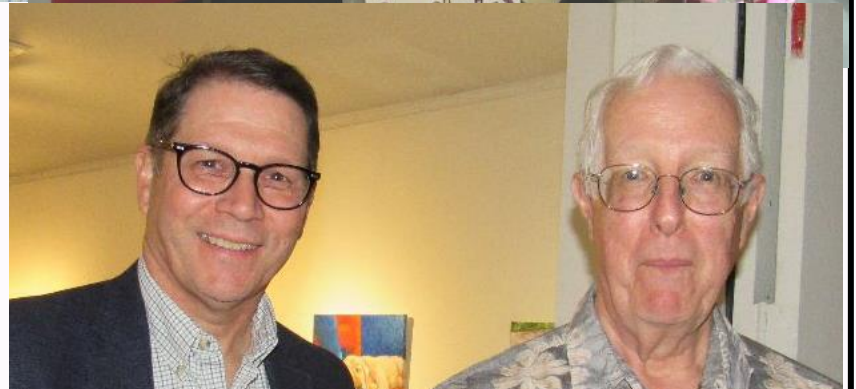

DAVIS COLLEGE DEMs UPDATE by **Brooke Pritchard (DCD Pres.)**



The Davis College Democrats are thrilled to announce that our 13th Annual Indigo Awards fundraiser is just around the corner! The Indigo Awards is our main fundraiser of the year which provides funding and support for our many planned activities throughout the year.

This past year, we were named the **College Chapter of the Year by the California Young Democrats** because of our outstanding efforts in the midterm elections. DCD **canvassed six weekends** in a row, flipping seats in the Central Valley, Orange County, and Nevada. We knocked on 3,800 doors and our members put in over 1,000 hours of work. Our hard work continued this year, registering over 600 voters and campaigning for Yolo County Supervisor candidates Angel Barajas and Jim Provenza. We also grew our membership to record levels and brought dozens of members to both the CYD Tahoe Retreat and the California Democratic Party Convention.

2020 marks the most important election in a generation. With our growing membership, we have the opportunity to send our members to campaign in competitive races across California, Arizona, and Nevada. We are planning to return to California's 7th and 10th congressional districts as well as Nevada. Additionally, we are hoping to expand our reach to Arizona-- a crucial swing state for both the Presidential and US Senate races. We will also continue our work in important local races, including for the DCD Alumni Club President Jack Zwald. Finally, we want to ensure that Davis students are counted in the census, grow our partnerships with other chapters, further expand our membership, and advocate on important issues at the state and local level.
